

# FRENCH APPLE CAKE

- 1 cup all-purpose flour, spooned into measuring cup and levelled-off
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- ¼ teaspoon salt
- 1 stick (½ cup) unsalted butter, at room temperature
- ⅔ cup granulated sugar, plus more for sprinkling over cake
- 2 large eggs
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 3 tablespoons milk
- 2 baking apples, peeled, cored and cut into ½-inch cubes (3½ 4 cups chopped)
- Icing sugar (optional), for decorating cake

### **INSTRUCTIONS**

Preheat the oven to 350°F. Grease a 9-inch springform or regular cake pan with butter or nonstick cooking spray add parchment paper to pan. In a small bowl, whisk together the flour, baking powder and salt. Use beaters to cream the butter and granulated sugar until light and fluffy. about 3 minutes. Add the eggs, one at a time, beating well and scraping down the sides of the bowl after each addition. Beat in the milk and vanilla. Don't worry if the batter looks grainy at this point; that's okay. Add the flour mixture and mix on low speed until just combined. Using a rubber spatula, fold in the chopped apples. Scrape the batter into the prepared pan and even the top. Sprinkle evenly with 1 tablespoon of granulated sugar. Bake for about 40 minutes, Allow the cake to cool on a rack in the pan. Once cool, run a blunt knife around the edges of the cake. If using a springform pan, remove the sides. If using a regular cake pan, carefully invert the cake onto the rack, remove the parchment paper, then gently flip the cake over and place right-side-up on a platter. Using a fine sieve, dust with icing' sugar (if using).

### Instructions:

- 1. Line the sides and base of a 17cm cake tin. Preheat the oven to 180°.
- 2. Weigh or measure out the softened room temperature butter, add castor sugar and add the vanilla.
- 3. Beat the butter and sugar until well creamed, the mix will get fluffy and start to go from yellow to white.
- 4. Beat in the eggs, one at a time, otherwise the cream mixture will split.
- 5. Fold in the flour, use a wooden spoon or spatula for this step. Fold in the milk, until well mixed.
- 6. Pour into your lined cake tin and bake at 180 degrees for 40 minutes or until the skewer comes out clean, when pierced in the centre. The cake should be golden in colour.
- 7. Cool in the tin for around 10 minutes before turning out onto a wire rack.
